Library Memberships

Library membership is free to anyone who lives in Innisfil year-round, owns property in Innisfil, works or attends school in Innisfil, or owns/runs a business in Innisfil.

Personal information is collected under the authority of the Public Libraries Act, R.S.O. 1990 and will be used only in the management of library services.

To protect your confidentiality and to access your library information, you **must** bring your card to the library.

Placing Holds

You may place holds on nearly all library materials. We will contact you by phone or email when items are ready for pick-up. We will keep your items on hold for one week. We will hold Video Games, BluRay and DVDs for 2 days, not including days the library is closed. If you do not pick up your holds they are passed on to the next person who has put them on hold or returned to the shelves. If you are unable to pick up your holds within the time period, you may request the items again.

Interlibrary Loan Service


We are able to provide print materials from other libraries in Ontario upon request. Please ask library staff for more information.

Renewals

Most library materials may be renewed 3 times. Video Games, BluRay and DVDs may only be renewed one time. Items with NEW stickers may not be renewed.



All library materials must be returned **before closing time** on the day they are due.

Heavy demand materials, such as best sellers, magazines and school project resources, may be restricted to loan periods of less than three weeks.

Number of Items Loaned

DVD/BluRay: 10 per person

Video Games: 3 per person

CDs: 6 per person

There is no limit on other types of materials, but from time to time items in high demand may be limited. Laptops are for in-library use only.

Overdue Notification

You are responsible for returning library materials on time. If you do not return materials your account will be charged and you may not be able to use library services until your fines are paid.

Fees and Fines

Library service is free for anyone who lives or works in Innisfil, unless materials are returned late, damaged or lost.

Materials returned in the drop boxes after closing on the due date are subject to fines.

Overdue Fines

The maximum overdue fee for a single item is \$5.00. Overdue fines are only calculated on days when the library is open.

Books, CDs, magazines:
\$0.20 per day, per item

Video Games, BluRay & DVDs:
\$1.00 per day, per item

Interlibrary Loans:
\$0.25 per day, per item

Non-Residents Fee

Membership for non-residents is \$40 per household, per year.

Lost Cards

Replacement cards are available at a cost of \$5.00.

Lost or Damaged Materials

Lost/damaged materials are billed at rates established by the Innisfil Public Library Board. Payment for lost or damaged materials is NOT refundable. Please do not purchase replacement items.
